Applying the MAX Pitch Count (by season) to BOTH regular and postseason games will eliminate the unrealistic high pitch counts (192, 171, 164, etc.) that sometimes occur.

By using the MAX pitch count for each season we are being very generous. The regular season league average is much lower.
